To visit a sandstone building, you must first travel to Jordan and then to the city of Petra. Petra is three to five hours south of the modern capital city of Amman by road. It was built in the desert of Wadi Araba and it is surrounded by huge sandstone hills. The visitor reaches Petra through a narrow passage only 5 meters wide between sandstone walls hundreds of meters high. This is called the Siq. Next to it was a dam. This protected the Siq from flooding. Because the Siq is the main route into the city, it was originally paved, but it is now covered with soft sand. Of course, because of its high walls there is very little light in the Siq. This makes the view at the end even more amazing. Suddenly, through a narrow opening in the rock, you catch your first sight of the Khazneh. The name means "Treasury", because it was believed that treasury had been hidden there. But it was probably a tomb, a temple, or perhaps both. The Nabataeans settled in Petra around 2,600 years ago.

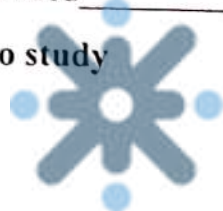
