Man's machines, cars, planes, trains and computers emit carbon dioxide which doesn't allow the heat from the sun to leave. When there is too much carbon dioxide in the atmosphere, the Earth's temperature goes up. This is called "global warming." We must slow down global warming. Here are some simple things we can do:

- Walk or take the bus to school.
- Reuse and recycle paper, glass, plastic and aluminium.
- Turn off the water while you brush your teeth.
- Turn off the lights, the heating, the air conditioning, the TV or computers when you don't use them. Don't play video games all the time: they use a lot of energy!
- Plant trees or start a vegetable garden.
- Wear cool clothes in summer and turn down the air conditioning. In winter, wear warm clothes and turn down the heating.
